John Hodge, Moulder, Initiated 6th February 1908	Sergeant, Australian Infantry (A.I.F.) 5th Batt	Killed in Action, 10 August 1918, aged 31 years. Buried at Fouquescourt British Cemetery (Somme) Son of Joseph and Mary C. Hodge, of 35 Park Road, Brechin. (CWGC Certificate downloaded)
George Robert Cushnie, Initiated 1 st Feb 1912	Lance Corporal. 44 th Batt Canadian Infantry	Killed 19 th November 1916, aged 29 Son of Alexander Cushnie, of Crossroads, Kinnell, Froickheim. Remembered at Adanac Military Cemetery, Miraumont. (CWGC Certificate downloaded)
James Watson, Initiated 12 th Dec 1895	Private, 3 rd Regt, South African Infantry.	Killed 18 th July 1916, Age 45 Son of James & Mary Ann Davidson Watson, Born at Brechin. Enlisted in Lovat Scouts 1901. Served in South African Campaign. Re-enlisted 1914 Remembered at the Thiepval Memorial (CWGC Certificate downloaded)
Charles Peter Beedie, Initiated 9 th Jan 1902	Private, 7 th Batt Bedfordshire Regiment	Killed 15 th August 1917 Remembered at Yper (Menin Gate) Memorial (CWGC Certificate downloaded)
Frank Whyte Munro, Grocer, Initiated 3rd January 1918.	?	Killed in Action, August 1918, aged 24 years - Not mentioned on the CWGC lists, nor on the Brechin War Memorials. The nearest I can get is a Frank Munro – Canadian Infantry who was killed in August 1918.

Robert Annandale, Stoker, Royal Navy, Melgund Mill, Near Brechin. Initiated 18th February 1926, aged 24, Born in Dundee in 1902	Stoker, Royal Navy.	Killed on 25th November 1941, on H.M.S. Barham. Son of James and Ann Annandale; Husband of Laura Elizabeth Annandale. (CWGC Certificate downloaded)
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
